THE HOLY SPIRIT IN THE OLD TESTAMENT

When we think about the Holy Spirit most of us probably think about the New Testament. That's certainly not surprising as we're given much information about him there. However, it is good to be reminded that the Holy Spirit is active throughout the Old Testament as well.

Though some interpret it a bit differently, I believe we find the Holy Spirit in the second verse of the Bible. "The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters." (1:2) In 6:3 we find this statement: "My Spirit shall not abide in (or "contend with") man forever, for he is flesh: his days shall be 120 years." I take this to mean that the Spirit was abiding, or contending, with man in some unspecified way very early in man's existence.

Moving forward in the history of mankind we come to the nation of Israel, God's chosen covenant people. The Holy Spirit was quite active amongst them. Sometimes he would fill the prophets so that they could speak on God's behalf to the people. (2 Samuel 23:2; 2 Peter 1:19-21) At other times the Spirit would fill people so as to equip them with the necessary skill, ability, and knowledge to perform a certain function. (Numbers 11:17; Exodus 31:1-5; Judges 6:34, etc.)

What I find most interesting and significant about the Holy Spirit in the Old Testament is the number of prophecies that point ahead to a *new* work that would happen in the future. Ezekiel 36:25-27 says, "I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleanness, and

Even on your male and female servants in those days I will pour out my Spirit." (see Acts 2:17-18)

Jesus, too, had things to say to his disciples about the Holy Spirit and his work with all believers in the days ahead. Luke 11:13 and John 7:37-39 are examples.

The Holy Spirit was present and active in Old Testament times. Through prophesy we learn that he would continue to be active in new ways moving forward. We will talk more about that in the future. Adam Litmer
